Artificial intelligence is now an integral part of everyday life: from social media to search engines, from study apps to recommendation systems. However, alongside opportunities, risks and critical issues also emerge that are essential to understand, especially for young people.

To navigate the digital age, it is essential to verify sources through lateral reading and recognise deepfakes by analysing visual or audio anomalies. AI hallucinations and algorithmic biases show that generative models do not "understand" facts, but replicate statistical patterns that are often distorted. Developing critical thinking allows us to distinguish human consciousness from artificial computation, protecting ourselves from information manipulation.
